### **FLU PREVENTION**

Mrs. Michaud, our school nurse, has urged us to be more aggressive in preventing the spread of flu and flu-like germs. We will be encouraging the use of water bottles in grades 1-5 rather than drinking directly from fountains. Students may bring water bottles to fill here. We have about 30 bottles if a student would like one. We will also be regularly sanitizing some common items like stairway railings and door handles.

It is important that if a student has a fever he or she not come back to school until 24 hours **AFTER** being fever free without medication.

### **HOT LUNCH ACCOUNTS**

*THERE IS A SMALL BUT INCREASING NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO ARE GETTING HOT LUNCH WITHOUT ENOUGH FUNDS ON THEIR ACCOUNTS. SJRS is responsible for tracking and collecting from those families who owe the Concord School district for lunch. We remind you of the various ways to pay:*

Cash or checks made out to the Concord School District for the lunch program can be brought into the office any day. The amount brought in will be credited to the student's account the same day.

You may also go online to [www.K12paymentcenter.com](http://www.K12paymentcenter.com) at anytime and use your credit or debit card to add money to your child's account. **THERE IS A \$ 1.95 EVERY TIME YOU USE THIS ONLINE CHOICE.** There is no limit to how much you place on an account at once. Using the online system will also allow you to sign up for notifications of when a student's account is a certain dollar amount (for example, when it is running out)
