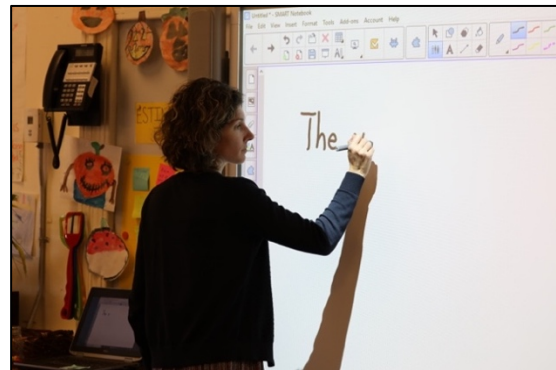
- Daily prayer and religion class

- We have a vibrant PTO that organizes many social functions each year. They also support activities for our students which expand and enrich their education experiences.

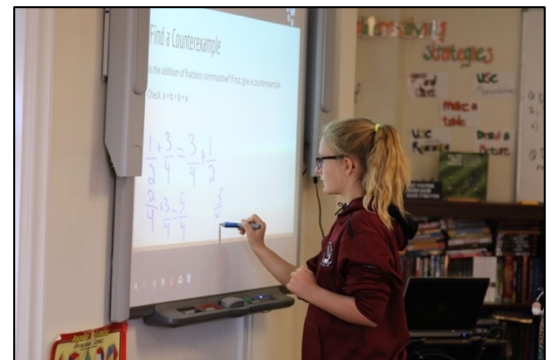


- School volunteers assist in classrooms, help individual students, and foster the Mission of the school.

Academic Excellence

St. John Regional School offers a rigorous curriculum using continually updated textbooks and materials. We provide our students with a strong foundation in the following areas:

- Math – Our math program focuses on student success through incremental development and continual review which emphasize both concepts and basic operations. Online math support is also available to students. Students in Grades 4 through 8 have the opportunity to participate in the Mathematical Olympiad and MATHCOUNTS competitions.
- Science – Hands-on experiments, use of microscopes and field trips are part of our program. Students in Grades 5 through 8 participate in the annual Science Fair.
- Language Arts - Students learn about storytelling by reading novels. Reading allows them to focus on expanding their vocabulary. Grammar, usage and mechanics are improved by reading and following the writing process.
- Reading – Through early literacy activities and programs that include explicit phonics instruction, students learn to become emergent readers. From



a young age, students are introduced to a variety of literary genres. As they become independent readers,

- Vocabulary – In Grades 4-8, we utilize Sadlier Vocabulary to expand our students' study of language as it relates to
- Social Studies – Emphasis on a better understanding of world cultures and a fuller realization of American History and Government encompass our program. Students in Junior High participate in the annual National Geographical Geography Bee.
- Spanish – Our Spanish program begins informally in PK-2. In Grades 3-8, classroom instruction becomes formalized. Throughout the program, students are exposed to the Spanish culture and traditions.
- Religion – We provide a firm foundation in the Catholic Faith both in terms of knowledge and spiritual experiences.
- Art, Physical Education, Music, Computer Technology, and Public Speaking are part of our enrichment offerings.
