AN ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT THAT INSPIRES STUDENTS TO LEARN

Founded in 1888, St. John Regional School is a private Catholic elementary school serving students from Pre-kindergarten through Grade 8. Our focus on faith, family, and community are the reasons families entrust us with the education of their children. We offer a rigorous curriculum that instills a love of learning and builds a strong foundation for a lifetime of academic and personal success. Using current materials and technology, our students are challenged to reach their full potential across a comprehensive set of disciplines.

MATHEMATICS

Our Math program focuses on student success through incremental development and continual review. Concepts and basic operations are reinforced through online support available to students. Students in Grades 4 – 8 have the opportunity to participate in the Mathematical Olympiad and MATHCOUNTS, a national middle school competitive mathematics program that promotes mathematical achievement through fun and engaging contests.

SCIENCE

STEM concepts are an integral part of our curriculum. Students are introduced to robotic concepts at an early age. Later, the focus shifts to hands-on learning and research-based writing. In Grades 5 – 8, students participate in the annual Science Fair which provides an opportunity to showcase student learning. With an emphasis on hands-on investigation, the Science Fair allows students to build on their classroom experience through research and experimentation.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Reading and following the writing process improves grammar, usage, and mechanics.

Through early literacy activities and programs that include explicit phonics instruction, students grow as emergent readers and expand both comprehension and vocabulary development.



Each year, all students in Grades 5–8 participate in the Scripps National Spelling Bee. A school-wide Spelling Bee involving the top spellers from each class. One winner advances to the State competition.

VOCABULARY

In Grades 3 – 8, we utilize Sadlier Vocabulary to expand our students' study of language. Each student reaches academic success by building their vocabulary using research-based word lists, instruction, and practice.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Social Studies emphasizes a deeper understanding of world cultures and a fuller realization of American History and Government. The curriculum includes content-based research and a focus on improving writing-skills. Students in Junior High participate in the annual National Geographical Geography Bee.

RELIGION

We provide a firm foundation in the Catholic Faith both in terms of knowledge and spiritual experiences. While our students come from a variety of backgrounds, they all share experiences of faith and values. Together we create a community built on love and respect. Values are instilled through daily prayer and religion class, community service both in and out of school, and school masses and prayer services.

SPANISH

Our Spanish program begins in kindergarten.

In Grades 3 –8 language instruction becomes more formalized. Students are also exposed to the Spanish culture and traditions. Our students often achieve advanced placement when they move up to high school.

ENRICHMENT

Art, Physical Education, Music, Computer Technology, and Public Speaking are part of our enrichment offerings. Each subject plays a vital role in developing students who are well-rounded and positioned for success.



DEVOTED FACULTY AND STAFF

Our faculty and staff continually strive to nurture the intellectual curiosity of our students and instill enthusiasm for learning. Each member of our faculty is State certified and many hold masters degrees in education or related subjects. Together, they provide a caring and supportive learning environment.

Here at St. John's, we are fortunate to have an extraordinary level of parent volunteers. Our parents create a strong school community where lifetime friendships are formed. We have a vibrant PTO that organizes many social functions each year and supports activities for our students that expand and enrich their educational experiences. Volunteers assist in classrooms, help individual students, and foster the Mission of the school.



During Catholic Schools week we set aside a day for service, and each month, the Pre-K through Grade 8 classes collect items needed for charitable organizations in the community. Our older students mentor our younger students and work together to better the community.
